6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to entry of persons under age 21 to
7 licensed premises."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.16.049(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) A person under the age of 21 years may not knowingly enter
11 or remain in premises licensed under this title unless

12 (1) accompanied by a [PARENT, GUARDIAN OR] spouse who has
13 attained the age of 21 years;

14 (2) the person is at least 16 years of age, the premises
15 are designated by the board as a restaurant for the purposes of this
16 section, and the person enters and remains only for dining; [OR]

17 (3) the person is under the age of 16 years, is accompanied
18 by a person over the age of 21 years, the parent or guardian of the
19 underaged person consents, the premises are designated by the board as
20 a restaurant for the purposes of this section, and the person enters
21 and remains only for dining;

22 (4) accompanied by a parent or guardian and the premises
23 are licensed as a package store under AS 04.11.150, licensed as a
24 common carrier dispensary under AS 04.11.180, or are entered for the
25 purpose of touring a bottling works, brewery, winery, wholesale ware-
26 house, or distillery; or

27 (5) accompanied by a parent or guardian and the parent or
28 guardian is licensed under this title to sell or serve alcoholic
29 beverages for consumption only on the licensed premises; in this

paragraph, "licensed under this title" includes being a partner in a partnership licensed under this title, or being an officer, director, or stockholder of a corporation licensed under this title.
