6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to absences from the state for
7 purposes of qualification for longevity bonus reim-
8 bursement payments; and providing for an effective

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 47.45.030 is amended by adding a new subsection to
12 read:

13 (b) Notwithstanding (a) of this section, when the commissioner
14 of administration determines a period of absence is beyond the control
15 of the recipient and the recipient still otherwise qualifies for a
16 bonus upon returning to the state, the recipient is entitled to bonus
17 reimbursement payments for the period of absence determined to be
18 beyond the control of the recipient.

19 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1989.
