BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 12.62.035(a) is amended to read:

(a) An [NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, AN] inter-

11

ested person [AS DEFINED IN (e) OF THIS SECTION] may request from the

12

Department of Public Safety [COMMISSION] records of all convictions

13

involving contributing to the delinquency of a minor, and convictions

14

involving any sex crimes of a person who holds or applies for a posi-

15

tion in which the person has or would have supervisory or disciplinary

16

power over a minor. The Department of Public Safety [COMMISSION]

17

shall authorize the disclosure of the information to the requesting

18

interested person and shall provide a copy of the information to the

19

person who is the subject of the request.

(f) The Department of Education shall request and receive re-

ords under (a) of this section for a person seeking certification as
