Sec. 18.67.101. INCIDENTS AND OFFENSES TO WHICH AS 18.67.010 --

18.67.180 APPLY. The board may order the payment of compensation in

12

accordance with the provisions of this chapter for personal injury or

13

death that resulted from

14

(1) an attempt on the part of the applicant to prevent the

15

commission of crime, or to apprehend a suspected criminal, or aiding

16

or attempting to aid a police officer to do so, or aiding a victim of

17

crime; or

(2) the commission or attempt on the part of one other than

the applicant to commit any of the following offenses: murder in any

degree, manslaughter, criminally negligent homicide, assault in any

[THE FIRST OR SECOND] degree, kidnapping, sexual assault in any de-

gree, sexual abuse of a minor, robbery in any degree, threats to do

23

bodily harm, or driving while intoxicated or another crime resulting

from the operation of a motor vehicle, boat, or airplane when the

offender is intoxicated.
