7 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to eligibility for retirement under  
8 the teachers' retirement system."  
9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:  
10 \* Section 1. AS 14.25.110(a) is amended to read:  
11 (a) Subject to AS 14.25.167, a member is eligible for a normal  
12 retirement benefit if the member  
13 (1) was first hired before July 1, 1975, has attained the  
14 age of 55 years, and has at least 15 years of credited service, the  
15 last five of which have been membership service;  
16 (2) has attained the age of 55 years and has at least eight  
17 years of membership service;  
18 (3) has attained the age of 55 years, has at least five  
19 years of membership service, and has at least three years of Alaska  
20 BIA service;  
21 (4) has at least 25 years of credited service, the last  
22 five of which have been membership service;  
23 (5) has at least 20 years of membership service;  
24 (6) has at least 20 years of combined membership service  
25 and Alaska BIA service, the last five of which have been membership  
26 service; or  
27 (7) has, for each of 20 school years,  
28 (A) at least one-half year of membership service as a  
29 part-time teacher;  
(B) one full year of membership service as a full-time

1           teacher; or  
2                    (C) any combination of service qualified under this  
3           paragraph [FOR EACH OF 20 SCHOOL YEARS].
