10 and to duplicate licenses and tags; relating to the
11 definition of resident in fish and game laws; relat-
12 ing to use of revenue from sport fishing, trapping,
13 and hunting licenses and tags; relating to the invol-
14 untary transfer of entry permits; and providing for
15 an effective date."
16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
17 * Section 1. AS 16.05.130 is amended by adding a new subsection to
18 read:
19 (d) Revenue from the sale of general hunting, trapping, and
20 fishing licenses and tags together with the federal matching funds
21 from Pittman - Robertson, Dingell - Johnson/Wallop - Breaux programs
22 shall be allocated by the department to programs intended to directly
23 benefit license purchasers of general hunting, trapping, and fishing
24 licenses. The department shall provide an annual report by project of
25 expenditures from the fish and game fund.
