A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the relocation to Ketchikan of
7 certain offices, functions, and employees of the
8 Alaska marine highway system."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 19.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 19.65.005. MARINE HIGHWAY SYSTEM BASED IN KETCHIKAN. The
12 headquarters of the Alaska marine highway system is located in
13 Ketchikan. The commissioner of transportation and public facilities
14 shall locate in Ketchikan the offices of (1) the director and assis-
15 tant director of the marine highway system, (2) the manager of marine
16 operations, (3) the manager of support services, (4) the manager of
17 customer services, and all other offices, functions, and employees of
18 the marine highway system, except those whom the commissioner deter-
19 mines must be located outside of Ketchikan in order to operate the
20 marine highway system.

21 * Sec. 2. The provisions of sec. 1 of this Act do not affect a collec-
22 tive bargaining agreement entered into on or before the effective date of
23 this Act.
