6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to representation of others by  
7 legislators and certain legislative employees before  
8 state agencies."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 24.60.100 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 24.60.100. REPRESENTATION. A person to whom this chapter  
12 applies who represents another person for compensation before an agen-  
13 cy, board, or commission of the state shall disclose the name of the  
14 person represented, the subject matter of the representation, and the  
15 body before which the representation is to take place in the journal  
16 of the appropriate body or if the legislature is not in session to the  
17 committee. The committee shall maintain a public record of the dis-  
18 closure and forward the disclosure to the respective house for inclu-  
19 sion in the journal by the fifth day of the session. However, a  
20 person to whom this chapter applies who is an attorney may represent a  
21 client before a court for compensation and that representation need  
22 not be disclosed.
