6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to continuation of teachers'  
7 salaries during collective bargaining."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.20.158 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 14.20.158. CONTINUED CONTRACT PROVISIONS. Continuation of  
11 the provisions of a teacher's contract under AS 14.20.145 or 14.20.155  
12 does not

13 (1) require that an employer increase the salary paid the  
14 teacher from the salary paid under the contract, notwithstanding any  
15 increase in the teacher's years of experience or education earned  
16 since the expiration of the contract [AFFECT THE ALTERATION OF THE  
17 TEACHER'S SALARY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SALARY SCHEDULE PRESCRIBED BY  
18 STATE LAW, OR IN ACCORDANCE WITH A LOCAL SALARY SCHEDULE APPLICABLE TO  
19 ALL TEACHERS IN THE DISTRICT AND ADOPTED BY BYLAWS];

20 (2) limit the right of the employer to assign the teacher  
21 to any teaching, administrative, or counseling position for which the  
22 teacher is qualified; or

23 (3) limit the right of the employer to assign the teacher,  
24 as is reasonably necessary, to any school in the district.

25 \* Sec. 2. The amendment to AS 14.20.158, made by sec. 1 of this Act,  
26 applies to teachers first hired on or after the effective date of this Act.
