For an Act entitled: "An Act making special appropriations for tourism and

recreation related projects, grants, and expenses of

state government; and providing for an effective

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt
12 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for
13 grants under AS 41.35.040 for historic preservation projects.

14 * Sec. 2. The sum of \$150,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
15 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for the opera-
16 tion of the Alaska Conservation Corps program for the fiscal year ending
17 June 30, 1990.

18 * Sec. 3. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
19 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for the develop-
20 ment of highway interpretive signs.

21 * Sec. 4. The sum of \$200,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
22 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for trail heads,
23 shelters, and a cabin at the Chena River State Recreation Area.

24 * Sec. 5. The sum of \$300,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
25 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for facilities
26 rehabilitation and improvements at the Chena River State Recreation Site.

27 * Sec. 6. The sum of \$50,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
28 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for completion
29 of the Chena Hot Springs Winter Trail.

1 * Sec. 7. The sum of \$250,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
2 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for payment as a
3 grant under AS 37.05.316 to the Fairbanks Historic Preservation Foundation
4 for the preservation and rehabilitation of the Riverboat Nenana.

5 * Sec. 8. The sum of \$15,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
6 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Administration for payment as a
7 grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Fairbanks North Star Borough for construc-
8 tion of an amphitheater at Alaskaland for the Fairbanks Native Association
9 Cultural Program.

10 * Sec. 9. The sum of \$185,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
11 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Administration for payment as a
12 grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Fairbanks North Star Borough for enhance-
13 ments at Alaskaland.

14 * Sec. 10. The sum of \$653,500 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
15 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for reconstruc-
16 tion and expansion of the Anchor River State Recreation Area and construc-
17 tion of a campground at Bing's Landing.

18 * Sec. 11. The sum of \$114,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
19 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Administration for payment as a
20 grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City of Homer for design and construction
21 of the Kachemak Bay State Park gateway building and visitor center facil-
22 ities.

23 * Sec. 12. The sum of \$95,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
24 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Administration for payment as a
25 grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City of Kenai for development of the Old
26 Town Viewing Area.

27 * Sec. 13. The sum of \$137,500 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
28 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Administration for payment as a
29 grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City of Soldotna for development of the

1 Kenai River public boat ramp and parking area.

2 * Sec. 14. The sum of \$700,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
3 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Transportation and Public Facil-
4 ities for major road maintenance in the Hatcher Pass Public Use Area.

5 * Sec. 15. The sum of \$200,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
6 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for facilities
7 rehabilitation and improvements at the Finger Lake Recreation Site.

8 * Sec. 16. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
9 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for development
10 of road access to the Willow Creek State Recreation Area.

11 * Sec. 17. The sum of \$336,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
12 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for improvement
13 of access points to the Eagle River Greenbelt.

14 * Sec. 18. The sum of \$300,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
15 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for facilities
16 rehabilitation and improvements at the Eagle River Visitor Center building.

17 * Sec. 19. The sum of \$150,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
18 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for Turnagain
19 Arm scenic corridor improvements.

20 * Sec. 20. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
21 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for public
22 toilets and public drinking water systems in Chugach State Park.

23 * Sec. 21. The sum of \$75,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
24 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for design of
25 the Toilsome Drive By-Pass Road in Chugach State Park.

26 * Sec. 22. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
27 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for joint cost-
28 sharing projects with the U.S. Forest Service in the Chugach National
29 Forest.

1 * Sec. 23. The sum of \$200,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
2 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Administration for payment as a
3 grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Municipality of Anchorage for stream reha-
4 bilitation projects in the amounts listed:

5	Rehabilitation of Fish, Campbell,	
6	Chester, and Furrow creek systems	\$140,000
7	Industrial trash removal	60,000

8 * Sec. 24. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
9 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for payment as a
10 grant under AS 37.05.316 to the Alaska Aviation Heritage Museum for resto-
11 ration of historic aircraft.

12 * Sec. 25. The sum of \$109,400 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
13 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Fish and Game for the development
14 of tourist-related facilities at the following state hatcheries and in the
15 amounts listed:

16	Fort Richardson Hatchery	\$25,000
17	Elmendorf Hatchery	37,200
18	Big Lake Hatchery	25,200
19	Crooked Creek Hatchery	22,000

20 * Sec. 26. The sum of \$500,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
21 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Administration for payment as a
22 grant under AS 37.05.316 to the Alaska Native Cultural Center Corporation
23 for predevelopment of an Alaska Native heritage presentation center.

24 * Sec. 27. The sum of \$20,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
25 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Administration for payment as a
26 grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Municipality of Anchorage for development
27 of the Government Hill Port Overview Park.

28 * Sec. 28. The sum of \$300,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
29 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Administration for payment as a

1 grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Municipality of Anchorage for waterfront
2 redevelopment for Ship Creek Overlook Park.

3 * Sec. 29. The sum of \$367,500 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy
4 fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Natural Resources for Chugach
5 State Park access development for the following projects and in the amounts
6 listed:

7 Glen Alps access \$315,500

8 Upper Huffman access 52,000

9 * Sec. 30. The appropriations made by secs. 3 - 7, 10, 14 - 22, 24 -
10 26, and 29 of this Act are for capital projects and are subject to AS 37.-
11 25.020.

12 * Sec. 31. The unexpended and unobligated portion of the appropriations
13 made by secs. 1 and 2 of this Act lapse into the Railbelt energy fund
14 June 30, 1990.

15 * Sec. 32. This Act takes effect July 1, 1989.
