A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to absences from the state for
7 purposes of determining eligibility for permanent
8 fund dividends; and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 43.23.095(7) is amended to read:

11 (7) "state resident" means an individual who is physically
12 present in the state with the intent to remain permanently in the
13 state or, if the individual is not physically present in the state,
14 intends to return to the state and is absent only for any of the
15 following reasons:

16 (A) vocational, professional, or other specific educa-
17 tion for which a comparable program was not reasonably available
18 in the state;

19 (B) secondary or postsecondary education;

20 (C) military service;

21 (D) medical treatment;

22 (E) service in Congress;

23 (F) other reasons that [WHICH] the commissioner may
24 establish by regulation; [OR]

25 (G) service in the Peace Corps; or

26 (H) service in a foreign nation providing assistance
27 to needy individuals for a nonprofit organization while receiving
28 minimal payment as determined by the commissioner;

29 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1990.
