Sec. 09.63.010. OATH, AFFIRMATION, AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT IN THE

STATE. The following persons may take an oath, affirmation, or
acknowledgment in the state:

(1) a justice, judge, or magistrate of a court of the State
of Alaska or of the United States;

(2) a clerk or deputy clerk of a court of the State of
Alaska or of the United States;

(3) a notary public;

(4) a United States postmaster; [OR]

(5) a commissioned officer under AS 09.63.050(4); or

(6) a municipal clerk.
