9 * Section 1. AS 09.63.010 is amended to read:
10 Sec. 09.63.010. OATH, AFFIRMATION, AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT IN THE
11 STATE. The following persons may take an oath, affirmation, or
12 acknowledgment in the state:
13 (1) a justice, judge, or magistrate of a court of the State
14 of Alaska or of the United States;
15 (2) a clerk or deputy clerk of a court of the State of
16 Alaska or of the United States;
17 (3) a notary public;
18 (4) a United States postmaster; [OR]
19 (5) a commissioned officer under AS 09.63.050(4); or
20 (6) a municipal clerk carrying out the clerk's duties under
21 AS 29.20.380.
