6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the transfer of a limited entry  
7 permit to a minor in trust."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 16.43.150 is amended by adding a new subsection to  
10 read:

11 (i) Notwithstanding (g) of this section, an entry permit may be  
12 transferred by a probated will to a minor in trust until the minor  
13 reaches the age of majority, whether or not the minor is able to  
14 operate the gear for which the permit was issued. While the permit is  
15 being held in trust, the trustee has a fiduciary duty to arrange for a  
16 person to operate the gear. Notwithstanding (b) of this section, the  
17 person who operates the gear for the minor shall have the permit in  
18 possession at all times when operating the gear.

19 \* Sec. 2. AS 16.43.180 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

20 (c) The commission shall adopt regulations providing for the  
21 temporary transfer of an entry permit that is held in a testamentary  
22 trust for a minor under AS 16.43.150(i).
