A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act increasing alcoholic beverage license fees."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 04.11.090(b) is amended to read:

9 (b) The annual beverage dispensary license fee is \$2,500
10 [\$1,250].

 4 required to be affixed to the package by state or federal law are
 5 intact on the package. A wholesaler must obtain a general wholesale
 6 license for each distributing point. The annual general wholesale
 7 license fee is \$2,000 [\$1,000] for the first \$100,000 of business
 8 transacted, payable at the time of making an original application or
 9 an application for renewal. In addition, the following annual fees
 10 shall be paid by a holder of a general wholesale license:

25 (b) A wholesale malt beverage and wine license authorizes the
 26 holder to sell malt beverages and wine in the original packages in
 27 quantities of not less than five gallons. The holder of a wholesale
 28 malt beverage and wine license may not sell to a person not licensed
 29 under this title except as provided in AS 04.21.040. The annual

1 wholesale malt beverage and wine license fee is \$400 [\$200] for the
2 first \$20,000 of business transacted during a year, payable at the
3 time of making an original application or application for renewal. In
4 addition, the following annual fees shall be paid by a holder of a
5 wholesale malt beverage and wine license:

7 over \$20,000 and not over \$50,000	<u>\$. 600</u> [\$ 300]
8 over \$50,000 and not over \$100,000	<u>\$. 2,000</u> [\$ 1,000]
