A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to use of travel benefits by state
7 employees."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.90 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 39.90.030. TRAVEL BENEFITS. (a) If the cost of travel or
11 lodging was paid for by the state or if the employee was reimbursed by
12 the state for the cost, a state employee may not acquire or use, for
13 the employee's personal benefit, benefits offered for purchase of the
14 travel or lodging.

15 (b) This section does not prohibit a state employee from estab-
16 lishing a state travel account with an airline or other travel entity
17 or from requesting, if the account is established, that benefits
18 earned by travel at state expense be credited to that account. Bene-
19 fits earned on the employee's state travel account may only be used
20 for travel expenses incurred on state business.
