6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the right of foster parents to
7 intervene in certain proceedings; and amending
8 Rule 24, Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 25.23.120 is amended by adding a new subsection to
11 read:

12 (e) Upon timely application, a foster parent of a child who is
13 the subject of a petition for which a hearing is held under this
14 section shall be permitted to intervene in the proceeding.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 47.10.080 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

16 (1) Upon timely application, a foster parent of a child who is
17 the subject of a hearing that could lead to the termination of par-
18 ental rights with respect to the child shall be permitted to intervene
19 in the proceeding.

20 * Sec. 3. AS 25.23.120(e) and AS 47.10.080(1), as enacted by secs. 1
21 and 2 of this Act, have the effect of amending Rule 24, Alaska Rules of
22 Civil Procedure, by providing that foster parents have the right to inter-
23 vene in certain proceedings.
