6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing a two-year minimum durational
7 residency requirement for persons appointed to state
8 boards, commissions, and similar groups."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 39.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 39.05.062. RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR BOARDS AND COMMIS-
12 SIONS. Except when a longer durational residency is required by law
13 and except for members who serve ex officio, a person may not be
14 appointed to a board, commission, council, task force, or similar
15 group established by law unless the person has been a resident of the
16 state for at least two years immediately preceding the person's
17 appointment.

18 * Sec. 2. This Act applies to appointments made on or after the effec-
19 tive date of this Act.
