6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing the Anchorage to Kenai Peninsula  
7 and the Healy to Fairbanks power transmission lines  
8 and approving the design and construction costs of  
9 the lines; and providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. In accordance with AS 44.83.185(c) and contingent upon  
12 sec. 3 of this Act, the Alaska Energy Authority is authorized to design and  
13 construct a 138 kilovolt electric transmission line between Anchorage and  
14 the Kenai Peninsula at a cost of \$89,000,000. The transmission line shall  
15 be capable of being upgraded to 230 kilovolts.

16 \* Sec. 2. In accordance with AS 44.83.185(c) and contingent upon sec. 3  
17 of this Act, the Alaska Energy Authority is authorized to design and con-  
18 struct a 138 kilovolt electric transmission line between Healy and Fair-  
19 banks at a cost of \$60,000,000. The transmission line shall be capable of  
20 being upgraded to 230 kilovolts.

21 \* Sec. 3. The authorizations made by this Act are contingent upon  
22 written agreements between the Alaska Energy Authority and participating  
23 electric utilities providing that the participating utilities agree to pay

24 (1) the design and construction costs, that are in excess of  
25 \$125,000,000, for the electric transmission lines authorized by this Act;  
26 and

27 (2) the operation and maintenance costs of the electric trans-  
28 mission lines authorized by this Act.

29 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
