6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to powers of attorney."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 13.26 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9           Sec. 13.26.358. STATUTORY POWER NOT EXCLUSIVE. Except for  
10 AS 13.26.350(a), the medical proofs required under AS 13.26.-  
11 353(a)(1) - (2), and the affidavit in AS 13.26.356(b) when those  
12 provisions relate to a durable power of attorney, AS 13.26.332 -  
13 13.26.356 do not prevent a person from using another form or other  
14 language that under common law would create a valid and binding grant  
15 of a power of attorney.
