For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to residence in runaway minor facilities."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 47.10.320 is amended to read:

Sec. 47.10.320. RESIDENCE IN RUNAWAY MINOR PROGRAM FACILITIES.

A runaway minor may maintain residency for a period not exceeding 30

12

[45] days at a facility operated as part of a licensed program for

13

runaway minors. The minor may maintain residency without the consent

14

of the person or agency having custody of the minor, except that if

15

the court has ordered the minor committed to the custody of the de-

16

partment, written consent of the department is required. The resi-

17

dency may be extended for an additional period of 30 [45] days with

18

the written consent of the person or agency having custody of the

19

minor. A minor may not maintain residency beyond the 60th [90TH] day

20

following admission to a licensed program for runaway minors without

21

the written consent of the person or agency having custody of the

22

minor and the written consent of the department.
