A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the notice requirements for
7 adopting, amending, or repealing a regulation."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.62.190(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) At least 30 days before the adoption, amendment, or repeal
11 of a regulation, notice of the proposed action shall be

12 (1) published in the newspaper of general circulation, or
13 trade or industry publication, that the state agency prescribes and in
14 the Alaska Administrative Journal; if the proposed action will signif-
15 icantly affect a community, and if there is a local publication that
16 is distributed on a regular basis in the community, notice of the
17 proposed action shall also be published in the local publication; in
18 this paragraph, "community" means

19 (A) a municipality; and

20 (B) a place that is not a municipality and in which 25
21 or more persons reside as a social unit;

22 (2) mailed to every person who has filed a request for
23 notice of proposed action with the state agency;

24 (3) if the agency is within a department, mailed or de-
25 livered to the commissioner of the department;

26 (4) when appropriate in the judgment of the agency,

27 (A) mailed to a person or group of persons whom the
28 agency believes is interested in the proposed action, and

29 (B) published in the additional form and manner the

1 state agency prescribes;

2 (5) furnished the Department of Law together with a copy of
3 the proposed regulation, amendment, or order of repeal for the depart-
4 ment's use in preparing the opinion required after adoption and before
5 filing by AS 44.62.060;

6 (6) furnished to all incumbent State of Alaska legislators
7 and the Legislative Affairs Agency;

8 (7) furnished to the standing committee of each house of
9 the legislature having legislative jurisdiction over the subject
10 matter treated by the regulation under the Uniform Rules of the Alaska
11 State Legislature, together with a copy of the proposed regulation,
12 amendment, or order of repeal for the committee's use in conducting
13 the review authorized by AS 24.05.182;

14 (8) furnished to the staff of the Administrative Regulation
15 Review Committee.
