A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the definition of 'public ser-  
7 vant' in the criminal code."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 11.81.900(b)(48) is amended to read:

10 (48) "public servant" means each of the following, whether  
11 compensated or not, but does not include jurors or witnesses:

12 (A) an officer or employee of the state, a municipal-  
13 ity or other political subdivision of the state, or a govern-  
14 mental instrumentality of the state, including legislators,  
15 members of the judiciary, and peace officers;

16 (B) a person who participates as an advisor, consul-  
17 tant, or assistant at the request or direction of the state, a  
18 municipality or other political subdivision of the state, or a  
19 governmental instrumentality, or an employee of a person de-  
20 scribed in this subparagraph to the extent the employee as part  
21 of the employment assists the employer in the participation  
22 described in this subparagraph;

23 (C) a person who serves as a member of the board or  
24 commission created by statute or by legislative, judicial, or  
25 administrative action by the state, a municipality or other  
26 political subdivision of the state, or a governmental instrumen-  
27 tality;

28 (D) a person who has entered into a contract with the  
29 state, a municipality or other political subdivision of the

1 state, or a governmental instrumentality of the state, to carry  
2 out services funded in whole or in part by public money, or who  
3 is administering a grant from the state under AS 37.05.315 -  
4 37.05.317 or a grant from a municipality or other political  
5 subdivision of the state, or an employee of a person described in  
6 this subparagraph to the extent the employee as part of the  
7 employment assists the employer in the activities described in  
8 this subparagraph;

9 (E) a person nominated, elected, appointed, employed,  
10 or designated to act in a capacity defined in (A) - (D) [(A) -  
11 (C)] of this paragraph, but who does not occupy the position;
