6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the definition of 'public ser-  
7 vant' in the criminal code."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 11.81.900(b)(48) is amended to read:

10 (48) "public servant" means each of the following, whether  
11 compensated or not, but does not include jurors or witnesses:

12 (A) an officer or employee of the state, a municipal-  
13 ity or other political subdivision of the state, or a govern-  
14 mental instrumentality of the state, including legislators,  
15 members of the judiciary, and peace officers;

16 (B) a person, or employee of a person, participating  
17 [WHO PARTICIPATES] as an advisor, consultant, or assistant at the  
18 request of, the [OR] direction of, or under contract with the  
19 state, a municipality or other political subdivision of the  
20 state, or another [A] governmental instrumentality;

21 (C) a person who serves as a member of the board or  
22 commission created by statute or by legislative, judicial, or  
23 administrative action by the state, a municipality or other  
24 political subdivision of the state, or a governmental instrumen-  
25 tality;

26 (D) a person nominated, elected, appointed, employed,  
27 or designated to act in a capacity defined in (A) - (C) of this  
28 paragraph, but who does not occupy the position;
