6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to moorage fees charged by munic-
7 ipalities for small boats; and providing for an
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 29.10.200 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

11 (51) AS 29.35.135 (moorage fees)

12 * Sec. 2. AS 29.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

13 Sec. 29.35.135. MOORAGE FEES. (a) A municipality that charges
14 moorage fees for the use of docks and harbors owned or operated by the
15 municipality shall permit the moorage of boats that do not exceed 60
16 feet overall in length at no charge if

17 (1) moorage space is available; and

18 (2) the boat has the right to use moorage space in another
19 municipality for which a moorage fee has been paid to the other munic-
20 ipality.

21 (b) A municipality may require documentation of the fact that a
22 moorage fee has been paid to another municipality before granting a
23 boat moorage space without charge.

24 (c) This section applies to home rule and general law municipal-
25 ities.

26 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1990.
