5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to suspended imposition of sen-
7 tence."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 12.55.085(f) is amended to read:

10 (f) The court may not suspend the imposition of sentence of a
11 person who

12 (1) is convicted of a violation of AS 11.41.410 - 11.41.455;

13 (2) uses or possesses a firearm in the commission of the
14 offense for which the person is convicted; or

15 (3) is convicted of a violation of AS 11.41.210 - 11.41.250
16 or 11.41.510 - 11.41.530, and the person has, within the 10 years
17 preceding the commission of the offense for which the person has been
18 convicted, one or more prior convictions for a violation of AS 11.41
19 or for a violation of a law in this or another jurisdiction having
20 substantially similar elements to an offense defined in AS 11.41; for
21 the purposes of this paragraph, a person shall be considered to have a
22 prior conviction even if that conviction has been set aside under (e)
23 of this section or under the equivalent provision of the laws of
24 another jurisdiction.
