For an Act entitled: "An Act making appropriations for payment as grants
7 to the Matanuska-Susitna Borough for construction of
8 gas pipeline projects; and providing for an effective
9 date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. The following amounts are appropriated from the Railbelt
12 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Administration for payment
13 as grants under AS 37.05.315 to the Matanuska-Susitna Borough for the
14 construction of the following gas pipeline projects:

15 (1) ENSTAR Natural Gas Pipeline Company, Palmer	
16 gate station to Sutton, with a lateral line to the Palmer	
17 Correctional Facility	\$2,970,000
18 (2) Palmer to the Butte area	1,700,000
19 (3) Knik-Goose Bay Road to the Big Lake area via	
20 Vine Road, Hollywood Road, and Big Lake Road	1,940,000
21 (4) approximately 11.9 miles of gas pipeline along	
22 Vine Street and the Parks Highway to the Houston high school	
23 and the Houston senior center	2,200,000
24 (5) ENSTAR gas transmission line to the pro-	
25 posed Point MacKenzie Port	4,950,000

26 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1990.
