6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to charitable gaming; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 05.15.100 is amended by adding a new subsection to
10 read:

11 (d) Two to six permittees may work in conjunction in the same
12 location to conduct activities authorized by this section if each
13 permittee

14 (1) complies with the reporting requirements imposed on
15 operators under AS 05.15.083, provided that each permittee is required
16 to report information for its permit only; and

17 (2) has its financial records reviewed annually by a cer-
18 tified public accountant, and submits the results of the review to the
19 department no later than February 28 of the year following the year
20 for which the review is conducted.

21 * Sec. 2. AS 05.15.115(a) is amended to read:

22 (a) A municipality or qualified organization holding a permit to
23 conduct an activity under this chapter may enter into a contract with
24 an operator licensed under this chapter to conduct on behalf of the
25 municipality or qualified organization those activities permitted
26 under the authority of the permit. This section may not be construed
27 to require a permittee to enter into a contract with an operator to
28 conduct authorized activities.

29 * Sec. 3. AS 05.15.180(g) is amended to read:

1 (g) A municipality or a qualified organization may award a
2 maximum of \$1,000,000 in prizes each year in activities authorized
3 under this chapter; however, if a municipality or a qualified orga-
4 nization contracts with an operator to conduct on its behalf activ-
5 ities authorized under this chapter, the municipality or qualified
6 organization may award a maximum of \$500,000 in prizes each year. If
7 two or more permittees work in conjunction under AS 05.15.100(d), each
8 permittee may award the maximum of \$1,000,000 in prizes each year. In
9 this subsection "activities authorized under this chapter" means all
10 activities subject to this chapter other than bingo.

11 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
