A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to employees of the house and sen-
7 ate; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 24.10.060(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The house and senate employees of the legislature are hired
11 for the duration of each session upon the approval [RECOMMENDATION] of
12 the rules committee of each house. During the interim, house and
13 senate employees are hired with the approval of the president of the
14 senate or the speaker of the house of representatives, as appropriate.
15 Each legislator is entitled to two employees during the session and
16 one employee during the interim. The following additional employees
17 shall be provided for and this staffing level may not be increased or
18 decreased:

19 (1) two employees during the session and one employee
20 during the interim for each standing committee;

21 (2) one employee during the session and one employee during
22 the interim for each chair of a standing committee, other than a
23 finance committee;

24 (3) two employees during the session and one employee
25 during the interim for the chair of each finance committee;

26 (4) one employee during the session and two employees
27 during the interim for each special and joint committee; and

28 (5) one employee during the session and one employee during
29 the interim for the president of the senate, speaker of the house of

1 representatives, majority leader of the house and senate, and minority
2 leader of the house and senate.

3 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect May 14, 1990.
