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SIXTEENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

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A BILL

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For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the disclosure of substance abuse
by public officials and candidates for public of-
fice."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

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* Section 1. AS 39.90 is amended by adding a new section to read:

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ARTICLE 3. SUBSTANCE ABUSE BY PUBLIC OFFICIALS AND CANDIDATES.

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Sec. 39.90.200. SUBSTANCE ABUSE DISCLOSURE BY PUBLIC OFFICIALS

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AND CANDIDATES. (a) Each public official of the state or of a munic-
ipality of the state listed in AS 39.50.020 and each candidate for
elective office shall file a substance disclosure statement from a
qualified facility each time that a statement of income sources and
business interests is required to be filed under AS 39.50.

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(b) The commissioner of health and social services shall certify

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those facilities in the state that are qualified to conduct substance
testing of blood or urine for the presence of a controlled substance

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as described in AS 11.71.140 - 11.71.190 or for alcohol and shall

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publish the list of the qualified facilities in regulations of the
commissioner.

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
