7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the twenty-third annual Boys' State will be held June 7 - 16,

1989, at Camp Carrol on Fort Richardson under the sponsorship of the Ameri-

can Legion and cooperating organizations; and

WHEREAS this fine annual program is dedicated to increasing the dele-

gates' awareness of their future roles in state and local government as

well as promoting interest and knowledge about the operation of our system

of government; and

WHEREAS it is only through an admirable combination of volunteer

effort and the enterprising talents of generous individuals who do not

17

receive government or taxpayer monetary support that this week-long youth

citizenship exercise known as Boys' State takes place; and

WHEREAS the legislature would like to encourage state and local legis-

lators and other public officials and agencies to volunteer their services

and to provide copies of state publications and materials related to the

program;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature applauds the sponsors
