5 Relating to holding the Greatland Games
6 in the Palmer and Wasilla area in con-
7 junction with the Alaska State Fair.
8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
9 WHEREAS the Greatland Games is the name of a rapidly growing state
10 sports festival for amateur sports enthusiasts from all over Alaska; and
11 WHEREAS establishing a more permanent location for the games will
12 allow the games to be more satisfactorily scheduled and properly promoted
13 and will encourage many more potential competitors to participate; and
14 WHEREAS the communities in the greater Palmer and Wasilla areas have
15 the facilities needed to host the games in conjunction with the Alaska
16 State Fair; and
17 WHEREAS the games were held successfully at the Alaska State Fair in
18 1988 after the Governor endorsed the games by executive proclamation; and
19 WHEREAS the city of Palmer and the city of Wasilla have adopted res-
20 olutions supporting the holding of the games in the greater Palmer and
21 Wasilla area in conjunction with the Alaska State Fair;
22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature supports holding the
23 Greatland Games in the Palmer and Wasilla area as an added attraction of
24 the Alaska State Fair.
