7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the State of Alaska has an enormous investment in information
9 resources and services including computer services and telecommunications
10 and information management; and

WHEREAS the state should develop an effective management approach for
12 information services, including planning, policy development, budgeting,
13 procurement, and service delivery; and

WHEREAS planning, budgeting, and appropriations should be linked
15 together to ensure mission support;

16

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that an Information
17 Systems Special Committee is established to develop recommendations for the
18 legislature on ways to improve state development, acquisition, operation,
19 and management of information technology resources; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Information Systems Special Committee con-
21 sists of nine members, including one member from the Senate, appointed by
22 the president of the senate; one member of the House of Representatives,
23 appointed by the speaker of the house; two members from the private sector
24 who are knowledgeable about information resources management, appointed by
25 the governor; one member from the general public, appointed by the gover-
26 nor; the governor or the person the governor has designated to chair the
27 Telecommunications Information Council; one member from the information
28 systems committee in the Department of Administration, appointed by the
29 chair of the committee; one member from the judicial system, appointed by

1 the chief justice of the state supreme court; and one member of the Univer-
2 sity of Alaska, appointed by the president of the university; and be it

3 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Information Systems Special Committee shall
4 report its findings to the legislature by the first day of the Seventeenth
5 Alaska State Legislature and terminates on the adjournment of the First
6 Session of that legislature.
