Declaring April 20, 21, and 22, 1990, as

Disabled American Veterans Days.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Disabled American Veterans, a national organization, first

chartered a chapter in Anchorage on March 5, 1959; and

WHEREAS in October, 1988, the Anchorage chapter opened the first

11

veterans' crisis center in the state and, since that time, has served more

12

than 3000 veterans and their widows and dependents; and

WHEREAS, in June, 1989, through the combined efforts of chapters in

14

Anchorage, Fairbanks, and Matanuska-Susitna Borough, the Alaska Department

15

of the Disabled American Veterans was established and first elected chapter

16

officers on September 9, 1989; and

WHEREAS the Alaska department will convene its first annual convention

in Anchorage on April 20 - 22, 1990;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature declares April 20,

20

21, and 22, 1990, as Disabled American Veterans Days in Alaska.
