2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 44
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 SIXTEENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION
5 Relating to the development of a visitor
6 center for Wrangell-St. Elias National
7 Park and Preserve in the vicinity of
8 Glennallen.
9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
10 WHEREAS the Wrangell-St. Elias National Park and Preserve encompasses
11 magnificent scenery and outstanding natural and cultural resources; and
12 WHEREAS the Wrangell-St. Elias National Park and Preserve has been
13 designated as a World Heritage Site; and
14 WHEREAS there is developed access to and within the Wrangell-St. Elias
15 National Park and Preserve; and
16 WHEREAS it would benefit the state's economy to establish tourist
17 destinations that encourage tourists to travel throughout the state and
18 through its communities on its highway system; and
19 WHEREAS the state wants to celebrate in 1992 the 50th anniversary of
20 the completion of the Alaska Highway by promoting and enhancing tourist
21 destinations that are accessible by travelers using the Alaska Highway;
22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature supports National
23 Park Service development of a visitor center featuring the natural and
24 cultural resources of the Wrangell-St. Elias National Park and Preserve to
25 be located in the Copper River Basin where it will help draw attention to
26 the park.
