on Tourism.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS tourism is of increasing importance to the economy of the
9 state; and

10 WHEREAS the legislature should be well informed about developments in
11 tourism in order to plan for the state's future; and

12 WHEREAS the state should promote tourism and enhance opportunities for
13 visitors to experience Alaskan life and scenic grandeur; and

14 WHEREAS the future of tourism in the state may be affected by the
15 March 1989 oil spill in Prince William Sound;

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that a House Special
17 Committee on Tourism is established to study issues relating to tourism;
18 and be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED that the speaker of the House shall determine the
20 number of representatives to be members of the committee, and shall appoint
21 the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED that the House Special Committee on Tourism may meet
23 during and between sessions of the Sixteenth Alaska State Legislature, and
24 is terminated on the convening of the First Session of the Seventeenth
25 Alaska State Legislature.
