A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to enforcement of designated parking  
7 for handicapped persons."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 28.35.235 is amended by adding a new subsection to  
10 read:

11 (c) The commissioner may authorize a handicapped adult to be a  
12 parking enforcement specialist who may enforce this section by issuing  
13 citations to violators. The commissioner may delegate the authority  
14 to designate parking enforcement specialists under this subsection to  
15 the head of a local law enforcement agency. A local law enforcement  
16 agency may also authorize a handicapped adult to enforce an ordinance  
17 that prohibits unauthorized parking in specially designated places  
18 reserved for disabled or medically handicapped persons. A citation  
19 issued by a parking enforcement specialist under this subsection has  
20 the same effect as a citation issued by a law enforcement officer to  
21 enforce this section. A parking enforcement specialist under this  
22 subsection

23 (1) does not have arrest authority;

24 (2) is not authorized by this subsection to carry firearms;

25 (3) is not considered an employee of the state or a politi-  
26 cal subdivision by virtue of being designated a parking enforcement  
27 specialist.
