10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. Section 47, ch. 79, SLA 1988, is amended to read:

12 TRANSITIONAL PROVISION. Notwithstanding AS 23.30.041(p), as enacted
13 by sec. 10 of this Act, for the period from July 1, 1988, until June 30,
14 1992 [1989], the term "rehabilitation specialist" as used in AS 23.30.041
15 includes a person who was actively employed for at least one year before
16 June 30, 1988, in providing rehabilitation services to an injured worker
17 receiving benefits under AS 23.30.

18 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
