9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
10 * Section 1. AS 47.37.170(g) is repealed and reenacted to read:
11 (g) A person may not bring an action for damages (1) based on
12 the decision under this section to take or not to take an intoxicated
13 or incapacitated person into protective custody, or to release a
14 person from protective custody, or (2) resulting from injuries incur-
15 red while in protective custody under this section. This subsection
16 does not apply to an action for damages caused by intentional miscon-
17 duct.
18 * Sec. 2. This Act applies to causes of action that accrue on or after
19 the effective date of this Act.
20 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
