A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making special appropriations from the Rail-
7 belt energy fund for municipal debt retirement and
8 economic development, economic development of unin-
9 corporated communities, and volunteer fire depart-
10 ments; transferring the balance of the Railbelt
11 energy fund to the general fund; and providing for an
12 effective date."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

14 * Section 1. The following amounts are appropriated from the Railbelt
15 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) to the Department of Administration for payment
16 as grants under AS 37.05.315 to the municipalities set out below for munic-
17 ipal debt retirement and, if a surplus remains following the retirement of
18 debt, long-term economic development projects:

 23 tive date of secs. 1 - 5 and 7 of this Act.
