6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making reappropriations from the Railbelt
7 energy fund; and providing for an effective date."
8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
9 * Section 1. FINDINGS AND INTENT. The legislature finds that the
10 Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority has included the amount
11 of interest expected to be earned on the \$30,000,000 reappropriated in
12 sec. 2 of this Act when computing the financial feasibility of the Healy
13 cogeneration project. It is the intent of the legislature that the Depart-
14 ment of Revenue transfer the \$30,000,000 reappropriated in sec. 2 of this
15 Act to the Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority on July 1,
16 1990, or immediately thereafter.
17 * Sec. 2. The sum of \$30,000,000 and the interest earned on that sum
18 beginning on July 1, 1990, are reappropriated from the Healy cogeneration
19 project reserve in the Railbelt energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general
20 fund to the Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority for the
21 design and construction of the Healy cogeneration project.
22 * Sec. 3. Contingent upon the execution of a long-term, no-cost lease
23 between the Alaska Railroad Corporation and the Municipality of Anchorage
24 that designates the Alaska Railroad Corporation's Government Hill bluff
25 land as open space or for public use, the sum of \$2,500,000 is reappropri-
26 ated from the Railbelt energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to
27 the Department of Administration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315
28 to the Municipality of Anchorage for road and bridge improvements for the
29 Anchorage Ship Creek Original Townsite Redevelopment Project, including

1 extension of Warehouse Avenue, realignment of C Street, and construction of
2 a Ship Creek pedestrian bridge.

3 * Sec. 4. The sum of \$1,250,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt
4 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Admin-
5 istration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City of Kenai
6 for senior congregate housing.

7 * Sec. 5. The sum of \$1,300,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt
8 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Admin-
9 istration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Municipality of
10 Anchorage for the airport water/waste water utility project.

11 * Sec. 6. Contingent on the transfer of the Alyeska Utilities, Inc.,
12 water and sewer system to the Municipality of Anchorage on or before
13 January 1, 1993, the sum of \$2,300,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt
14 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Admin-
15 istration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Municipality of
16 Anchorage to reconstruct and upgrade the Alyeska Utilities, Inc., water and
17 sewer system.

18 * Sec. 7. The sum of \$3,800,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt
19 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Com-
20 merce and Economic Development for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.316 to
21 the Anchorage Economic Development Corporation to enable it to carry out
22 its contract obligations under the development contract with Seibu Alaska,
23 Inc., dated September 20, 1989.

24 * Sec. 8. The sum of \$600,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt
25 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Natural
26 Resources for Eagle River campground park repairs, expansion, and road pav-
27 ing.

28 * Sec. 9. The sum of \$100,000,000 and the interest earned on that sum
29 beginning July 1, 1990, are reappropriated from the Railbelt energy fund

1 (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Alaska Energy Authority for the
2 design and construction of the 138 kilovolt electric transmission lines
3 between Anchorage and the Kenai Peninsula and between Healy and Fairbanks.

4 * Sec. 10. The sum of \$400,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt
5 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the University of Alaska
6 agriculture and forestry experiment station for the Mat-Su farm renovation.

7 * Sec. 11. The sum of \$100,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt
8 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Admin-
9 istration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City of Wasilla
10 for the Selina Lane extension.

11 * Sec. 12. The sum of \$500,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt
12 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Admin-
13 istration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City of Palmer
14 for job corps facility construction.

15 * Sec. 13. The sum of \$9,000,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt
16 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Alaska Railroad
17 Corporation for the purchase of locomotives, rolling stock, and associated
18 equipment costs.

19 * Sec. 14. The sum of \$1,700,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt
20 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Com-
21 merce and Economic Development for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.316 to
22 Golden Valley Electric Association for extension of three phase overhead
23 electrical distribution lines from McKinley Park to Carlo Creek and for
24 taps of local service.

25 * Sec. 15. The sum of \$24,800,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt
26 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the University of Alaska
27 Fairbanks for a natural sciences facility at the University of Alaska
28 Fairbanks.

29 * Sec. 16. The sum of \$16,800,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt

1 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the University of Alaska
2 Anchorage for a classroom and laboratory building at the University of
3 Alaska Anchorage.

4 * Sec. 17. The following amounts are reappropriated from the Railbelt
5 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Trans-
6 portation and Public Facilities for the following purposes:
