6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making reappropriations from the Railbelt  
7 energy fund, including reappropriations in the amount  
8 of \$30,000,000 and interest earned beginning July 1,  
9 1990, for the Healy cogeneration project, in the  
10 amount of \$9,500,000 for the Seward transmission line  
11 from Lawing to Fort Raymond substation, and in the  
12 amount of \$100,000,000 and interest earned beginning  
13 July 1, 1990, for 138 kilovolt electric transmission  
14 lines between Anchorage and the Kenai Peninsula and  
15 between Healy and Fairbanks; and providing for an  
16 effective date."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

18 \* Section 1. FINDINGS AND INTENT. The legislature finds that the  
19 Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority has included the amount  
20 of interest expected to be earned on the \$30,000,000 reappropriated in  
21 sec. 2 of this Act when computing the financial feasibility of the Healy  
22 cogeneration project. It is the intent of the legislature that the Depart-  
23 ment of Revenue transfer the \$30,000,000 reappropriated in sec. 2 of this  
24 Act to the Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority on July 1,  
25 1990, or immediately thereafter.

26 \* Sec. 2. The sum of \$30,000,000 and the interest earned on that sum  
27 beginning on July 1, 1990, are reappropriated from the Healy cogeneration  
28 project reserve in the Railbelt energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general  
29 fund to the Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority for the

1 design and construction of the Healy cogeneration project.

2 \* Sec. 3. Contingent upon the execution of a long-term, no-cost lease  
3 between the Alaska Railroad Corporation and the Municipality of Anchorage  
4 that designates the Alaska Railroad Corporation's Government Hill bluff  
5 land as open space or for public use, the sum of \$2,500,000 is reappropri-  
6 ated from the Railbelt energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to  
7 the Department of Administration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315  
8 to the Municipality of Anchorage for road and bridge improvements for the  
9 Anchorage Ship Creek Original Townsite Redevelopment Project, including  
10 extension of Warehouse Avenue, realignment of C Street, and construction of  
11 a Ship Creek pedestrian bridge.

12 \* Sec. 4. The sum of \$1,250,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt  
13 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Admin-  
14 istration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City of Kenai  
15 for senior congregate housing.

16 \* Sec. 5. The sum of \$1,300,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt  
17 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Admin-  
18 istration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Municipality of  
19 Anchorage for the airport water/waste water utility project.

20 \* Sec. 6. Contingent on the transfer of the Alyeska Utilities, Inc.,  
21 water and sewer system to the Municipality of Anchorage on or before  
22 January 1, 1993, the sum of \$2,300,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt  
23 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Admin-  
24 istration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Municipality of  
25 Anchorage to reconstruct and upgrade the Alyeska Utilities, Inc., water and  
26 sewer system.

27 \* Sec. 7. The sum of \$3,800,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt  
28 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Com-  
29 merce and Economic Development for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.316 to

1 the Anchorage Economic Development Corporation to enable it to carry out  
2 its contract obligations under the development contract with Seibu Alaska,  
3 Inc., dated September 20, 1989.

4 \* Sec. 8. The sum of \$600,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt  
5 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Natural  
6 Resources for Eagle River campground park repairs, expansion, and road pav-  
7 ing.

8 \* Sec. 9. The sum of \$100,000,000 and the interest earned on that sum  
9 beginning July 1, 1990, are reappropriated from the Railbelt energy fund  
10 (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Alaska Energy Authority for the  
11 design and construction of the 138 kilovolt electric transmission lines  
12 between Anchorage and the Kenai Peninsula and between Healy and Fairbanks.

13 \* Sec. 10. The sum of \$400,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt  
14 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the University of Alaska  
15 agriculture and forestry experiment station for the Mat-Su farm renovation.

16 \* Sec. 11. The sum of \$100,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt  
17 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Admin-  
18 istration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City of Wasilla  
19 for the Selina Lane extension.

20 \* Sec. 12. The sum of \$500,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt  
21 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of Admin-  
22 istration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City of Palmer  
23 for job corps facility construction.

24 \* Sec. 13. The sum of \$9,000,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt  
25 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Alaska Railroad  
26 Corporation for the purchase of locomotives, rolling stock, and associated  
27 equipment costs.

28 \* Sec. 14. The sum of \$1,700,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt  
29 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the Department of

1 Commerce and Economic Development for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.316  
2 to Golden Valley Electric Association for extension of three phase overhead  
3 electrical distribution lines from McKinley Park to Carlo Creek and for  
4 taps of local service.

5 \* Sec. 15. The sum of \$24,800,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt  
6 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the University of Alaska  
7 Fairbanks for a natural sciences facility at the University of Alaska  
8 Fairbanks.

9 \* Sec. 16. The sum of \$16,800,000 is reappropriated from the Railbelt  
10 energy fund (AS 37.05.520) in the general fund to the University of Alaska  
11 Anchorage for a classroom and laboratory building at the University of  
12 Alaska Anchorage.
