A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act exempting employment of more than eight but  
7 no more than 10 hours a day in certain workweek  
8 schedules of no more than four days during a seven  
9 day period from the requirement of paying overtime  
10 wages; and providing for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 \* Section 1. AS 23.10.060 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

13 (19) work performed by an employee under a voluntary shared  
14 workweek plan approved by the department under which work at the  
15 worksite is divided equally between two substantially similar crews  
16 that do not work at the same time and that each work at least three  
17 and no more than four consecutive days during a seven day period, for  
18 at least 30 hours a week but no more than 10 hours a day, performing  
19 substantially similar tasks.

20 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
