8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
9 * Section 1. AS 47.37.170(c) is amended to read:
10 (c) A person who voluntarily appears or is brought to an ap-
11 proved public treatment facility shall be examined by a licensed
12 physician or other qualified health practitioner as soon as possible.
13 The department shall, by regulation, determine which health practi-
14 tioners may be authorized to perform the examination. After the
15 examination, the person may be admitted as a patient or referred to
16 another health facility. The approved public treatment facility which
17 refers the person shall arrange for transportation.
