A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to access to criminal records; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 12.62.035(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an interested  
11 person [AS DEFINED IN (e) OF THIS SECTION] may request from the com-  
12 mission records of all criminal convictions involving [CONTRIBUTING TO  
13 THE DELINQUENCY OF A MINOR AND ANY SEX CRIMES OF] a person who holds  
14 or applies for a position as an employee of a school district or re-  
15 gional educational attendance area, or a position in which the person  
16 has or would have supervisory or disciplinary power over a minor. The  
17 commission shall authorize the disclosure of the information to the  
18 requesting interested person and shall provide a copy of the informa-  
19 tion to the person who is the subject of the request.

22 (1) "criminal" means involving a crime as defined in  
23 AS 11.81.900;

24 (2) "interested person" means a state agency, school dis-  
25 trict, regional educational attendance area, corporation, company,  
26 partnership, firm, association, organization, business trust, or  
27 society, as well as a natural person, that employs or solicits the  
28 employment of a person to serve with or without compensation in a  
29 position at a public school, or a position in which the person has or

1 would have supervisory or disciplinary power over a minor.

2 \* Sec. 3. AS 12.62.035 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

3 (f) The Department of Education shall request and receive re-  
4 cords under (a) of this section for a person seeking certification  
5 under AS 14.20.010 - 14.20.040, and request records on behalf of a  
6 school district or regional educational attendance area.
