For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to certain beverage dispensary
licensees."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. FINDING AND PURPOSE. The legislature finds that interna-
tional and domestic travelers are accustomed to receiving hospitality
services in their rooms for business entertainment and personal enjoyment.
The purpose of this Act is to enhance the accommodations and services
available to travelers visiting Alaska.

(g) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a holder of a
beverage dispensary license issued to a hotel, motel, resort, or
similar business that caters to the traveling public may stock alco-
holic beverages in guest rooms, for sale and consumption on the prem-
ises only. Alcoholic beverages stocked under this subsection must be
stored using a key or combination lock system within the guest room.
The licensee may provide a key or combination enabling a person to
obtain alcoholic beverages stocked in a guest room only to guests who
occupy the room and who are 21 years of age or older.
