For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to standardized railroad crossing
permit agreements of the Alaska Railroad Corporation;
and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 42.40.350 is amended by adding a new subsection to

11 read:

(e) The corporation may not utilize a standardized railroad

13

crossing permit agreement to grant access across railroad land unless

14

the agreement has been submitted to the legislature for its review and

15

has not been disapproved by the legislature by law within 60 legisla-

16

tive days from the day the agreement was submitted.

* Sec. 2. The Alaska Railroad Corporation shall submit a standardized

18

railroad crossing permit agreement to the legislature for review under

19

AS 42.40.350(e), as enacted by sec. 1 of this Act, by January 20, 1990.

* Sec. 3. Section 1 of this Act applies to railroad crossing permit

21

agreements entered into by the Alaska Railroad Corporation after the effec-

22

tive date of this Act.

* Sec. 4. Within one year from the date that a standardized railroad

24

crossing permit agreement may be utilized by the corporation under AS 42.-

25

40.350(e), as enacted by sec. 1 of this Act, the Alaska Railroad Corpo-

26

ration shall renegotiate all railroad crossing permit agreements entered

27

into under a standardized railroad crossing permit agreement on or before

28

the effective date of this Act.

* Sec. 5. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
