4 SIXTEENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 A BILL
6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making special appropriations for the effects
7 of the statewide cold-weather disaster; and providing
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. The sum of \$2,500,000 is appropriated from the general
11 fund to the Department of Environmental Conservation for grants under the
12 village safe water program to communities in the Northwest Arctic Borough
13 for sewer and water repair.

14 * Sec. 2. The sum of \$1,462,000 is appropriated from the general fund
15 to the Department of Education for a grant to the Southwest Region Rural
16 Education Attendance Area for reconstruction of the Aleknagik school.

17 * Sec. 3. The sum of \$500,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
18 the Department of Environmental Conservation under the village safe water
19 program for repair of the water system in Noatak.

20 * Sec. 4. The sum of \$78,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
21 the Department of Administration as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City
22 of Tanana for repair of the sprinkler system in the Tanana Elder's resi-
23 dence.

24 * Sec. 5. The sum of \$417,850 is appropriated from the general fund to
25 the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs, emergency management
26 assistance, for the City of Nome for sewer and water system repair and
27 other associated costs of the statewide cold-weather disaster.

28 * Sec. 6. The sum of \$700,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
29 the Department of Environmental Conservation for clean-up of the Unalakleet

1 oil discharge.

2 * Sec. 7. The sum of \$5,500,000 is appropriated from the general fund
3 to the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs, disaster relief fund,
4 for the statewide emergency declaration of disaster January 28, 1989 for
5 repair, renovation, and replacement of equipment and sewer and water sys-
6 tems damaged as a result of the severe cold weather and to provide economic
7 relief to communities that have experienced undue hardship due to increased
8 utility and maintenance costs resulting from the statewide cold-weather
9 disaster. The unobligated and unexpended balance of this appropriation
10 lapses to the general fund June 30, 1989.

11 * Sec. 8. The appropriations in secs. 1 - 6 of this Act are for capital
12 projects and are subject to AS 37.25.020.

13 * Sec. 9. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
