5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the issuance of general obliga-
7 tion bonds in the amount of \$60,450,000 for the
8 purpose of paying the cost of hospital and medical
9 facility construction, reconstruction, renovation,
10 and expansion of hospitals at Kodiak, Seward,
11 Soldotna, Ketchikan, Juneau, and Unalaska; and pro-
12 viding for an effective date."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

14 * Section 1. For the purpose of paying the cost of the construction,
15 reconstruction, renovation, and expansion of hospitals and medical facil-
16 ities at Kodiak, Seward, Soldotna, Ketchikan, Juneau, and Unalaska, general
17 obligation bonds of the state in the principal amount of not more than
18 \$60,450,000 shall be issued and sold. The full faith, credit, and re-
19 sources of the state are pledged to the payment of the principal of and
20 interest and redemption premium, if any, on the bonds. The bonds shall be
21 issued under AS 37.15 as those provisions read at the time of issuance.

22 * Sec. 2. If the issuance of the bonds is authorized by the qualified
23 voters of the state, a special fund of the state to be known as the "1990
24 Hospital Construction and Renovation Fund" shall be established, to which
25 shall be credited the proceeds of the sale of the bonds described in sec. 1
26 of this Act except for accrued interest and premiums.

27 * Sec. 3. The amount of \$14,500,000 is appropriated from the "1990
28 Hospital Construction and Renovation Fund" to the Department of Administra-
29 tion for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Kodiak Island Borough

1 to be used for the construction of a new hospital by the Kodiak Island
2 Borough.

3 * Sec. 4. The amount of \$9,500,000 is appropriated from the "1990
4 Hospital Construction and Renovation Fund" to the Department of Administra-
5 tion for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City of Seward to be
6 used for the construction of a new hospital facility by the City of Seward.

7 * Sec. 5. The amount of \$1,200,000 is appropriated from the "1990
8 Hospital Construction and Renovation Fund" to the Department of Administra-
9 tion for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City of Seward to be
10 used for the renovation of an existing hospital facility by the City of
11 Seward.

12 * Sec. 6. The amount of \$16,200,000 is appropriated from the "1990
13 Hospital Construction and Renovation Fund" to the Department of Administra-
14 tion for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City of Ketchikan to
15 be used for the expansion and remodeling of the Ketchikan General Hospital.

16 * Sec. 7. The amount of \$1,050,000 is appropriated from the "1990
17 Hospital Construction and Renovation Fund" to the Department of Adminis-
18 tration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Kenai Peninsula
19 Borough for renovation and expansion of the Central Peninsula Hospital in
20 the City of Soldotna.

21 * Sec. 8. The amount of \$15,000,000 is appropriated from the "1990
22 Hospital Construction and Renovation Fund" to the Department of Administra-
23 tion for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City and Borough of
24 Juneau for construction, reconstruction, and renovation of the Bartlett
25 Memorial Hospital.

26 * Sec. 9. The amount of \$3,000,000 is appropriated from the "1990
27 Hospital Construction and Renovation Fund" to the Department of Adminis-
28 tration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City of Unalaska
29 for the construction of a medical assistance facility by the City of

1 Unalaska.

2 * Sec. 10. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the quali-
3 fied voters of the state, the amount of \$211,575 or as much of that amount
4 as is found necessary is appropriated from the general fund of the state to
5 the state bond committee to carry out the provisions of this Act and to pay
6 expenses incident to the sale and issuance of the bonds authorized in this
7 Act. The amounts expended from the appropriation authorized by this sec-
8 tion shall be reimbursed to the general fund from the proceeds of the sale
9 of the bonds authorized by this Act.

10 * Sec. 11. The question whether the bonds authorized in this Act are to
11 be issued shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the state at the
12 next general election and shall read substantially as follows:

13 Proposition

14 State General Obligation Hospital Construction
15 and Renovation Bonds \$60,450,000

16 Shall the State of Alaska issue its general obligation
17 bonds in the principal amount of not more than \$60,450,000
18 for the purpose of paying the cost of capital improvements
19 for hospital and medical facility construction, remodeling,
20 expansion, and renovation in Kodiak, Seward, Soldotna,
21 Ketchikan, Juneau, and Unalaska?
