6 For an Act entitled: "An Act increasing the amount of a longevity bonus;  
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 47.45.010(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) A person who is 65 years of age or over, who resides in the  
11 state for at least two years immediately preceding application for a  
12 longevity bonus under this chapter, may apply to the commissioner of  
13 administration for qualification to receive a monthly bonus of \$275  
14 [\$250].

15 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1990.
